

**Public Hearing
Mill Road Subdivision
Council Chambers
January 23, 2008**

The meeting came to order at 7:00 p.m.

Attending – Mayor Jim Hammons, Council: Laura Schrader, Larry Coryell, Don Banning, Larry Baker, City Attorney Mark Fennessy, and City Clerk Sandra Johnson.

GUESTS: Dennis Dupuis, Jean Meyer, Jane Brown, Billie Foster, Chris Vanden Bos, Mitch Walters, and Katie Randall.

SUBDIVISION REVIEW: Mayor Hammons referred to a plat map that was made available. He pointed out that Mill Road Subdivision is a boundary adjustment; splitting one lot into two lots. Hammons asked if there were easements for utilities. Dennis Dupuis, public works, confirmed that there are two separate water lines and two separate sewer meters. Hammons asked if there were any questions, and added that fire chief Larry Chapel submitted a letter of stating that there was no reason to deny this subdivision based on any fire suppression concerns. No questions or comments from those present. Mayor Jim Hammons called for a motion to approve the preliminary plat for Mill Road Subdivision. **Motion** was made by Larry Baker to approve the Mill Road Subdivision Preliminary Plat and seconded by Larry Coryell. Laura Schrader-Yes, Don Banning – Yes. **Motion carried.**

Mayor Hammons closed the public hearing and opened the regular council meeting calling the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m., and led the pledge of allegiance.

NEW BUSINESS LICENSES: C.D.Bos Hair Design- Owner: Christine Vanden Bos. Business located at 402 G Mineral Avenue in Troy. Coryell asked if the business was also a residence. She replied; No. Banning asked questions regarding parking. He was assured that there was no problem. **Motion** was made to approve the new the business license for C.D. Bos Hair Design License by Laura Schrader and seconded by Larry Baker. Larry Coryell – Yes, Don Banning – Yes. **Motion carried.**

ORDINANCE NO. 603: Amend Present Council Date Ordinance to one day per month, 1st reading. Council discussed meeting dates; the council committee meetings can be at any time and need not be stated in the ordinance, but they do have to be posted if a quorum of the council will be present. Mayor Hammons read Ordinance No. 603 and called for a motion to approve setting council to be held the third Wednesday of each month. Larry Coryell made a **Motion** to approve with a second by Laura Schrader. Don Banning – Yes, Larry Baker – Yes. **Motion carried.**

COMMITTEE REPORT (Don Banning) – Police Department request to extend authority to a five mile radius: A meeting was held December 22, 2008 in the Mayors office. Attending were: detectives Robbie Bowe and Jim Sweet from the County Sheriff's Office, Chief of Police Mitch Walters, Mayor Hammons, and Don Banning Councilman. The consensus was that the City would keep the policy that was now in force which is to have the county request help from the city when needed. Larry Baker said he would still like to see the City have the authority; sometimes it takes too long for the County to respond. Hammons said, it's not like we cannot go out there, we

just need the County to request the City's assistance. Banning and Hammons stated they would like to leave it the way it is currently.

MINUTES OF JANUARY 09, 2008: A **Motion** was made by Don Banning to approve the Minutes of January 09, 2008 and seconded by Larry Coryell, Laura Schrader – Yes, Larry Baker- Yes. **Motion carried.**

CLAIMS: A **Motion** to approve claims in the amount of \$540.01 was made by Laura Schrader and seconded by Larry Baker. Coryell – Yes. Banning – Yes. **Motion carried.**

DEPARTMENT REPORTS: Hammons- City/School Property Exchange. The Council met with the school district regarding the parcel of land owned by the city that the school district would like to see used for the school athletic center. It is still being discussed and there will be another meeting. The proposed building would front on Fourth Street. There may need to be a survey done as well. City would keep the property that houses the green boxes and animal control building. More information will be given out by the school district as it becomes available. Troy Snowmobile Club- Hammons wanted the council to know that they are interested in re-visiting the process to allow snowmobile use on some city streets. Some years back there was talk about an ordinance to do this, but it never done. Police Chief Walters stated his view by saying that this would be no different than an ATV on the streets as long as the driver is obeying the law; however, snowmobiles aren't licensed for streets. In some towns it is allowed and they have routes designated by signs with snowflakes on them. Discussion followed. Reports from Schrader- None, Coryell - None, Banning- None. Larry Baker asked if there was anything we can do about the ice around the City Hall building. It is being taken care of as well as weather will permit. More discussion on snow plowing the streets followed.
