

**Troy City Council Meeting
Council Chambers
June 17, 2009**

The meeting came to order at 7:00 pm. Present: Council President, Don Banning. Council: Laura Schrader, Larry Coryell, Larry Baker, and City Clerk Sandra Johnson. Mayor - Jim Hammons excused absent.

PERMISSION FOR PARK USE: John Demmendaal would like to head a soccer camp. Soccer camp will be July 27 through July 31 in the mornings. Council had no questions, request was granted.

POLICE COMMISSION APPOINTMENT: Ed Hanson was reappointed to Police Commission by council. No dissent, all approved.
