ANIMAL CONTROL: Committee Report – The Committee, Phil Fisher, Fran McCully and City Attorney Charles Evans, discussed the option to board feral cats at the animal control officer's residence where she has multiple caging. It was the committee's consensus to continue using the contracted facilities. They feel it would be a liability to the City if the animal control officer boarded the feral cats. The idea of boarding them at the City Shop did come up but Police Chief Robert McLeod advised that it would take too many hours maintaining the animals instead of patrolling. Discussion followed regarding trapping and holding procedures. The option to use the animal control officer's residence to hold feral cats is not in the best interest of the City.
