

**Troy Council Special Meeting No. 2**

The meeting came to order at 8:10 pm. Present: Mayor Don Banning, Council: Phil Fisher, Fran McCully, and John Clogston, City Attorney Charles Evans, and Deputy Clerk Tracy Rebo. Gary Rose was absent.

**REVIEW, AMEND, OR REPEAL ORDINANCE #263: Defining Municipal Officers –** Mayor Don Banning advised that Ordinance # 263 has 15 sections, he read them aloud. Council Fran McCully stated there seems to be a quite a few things in this that we may want to address. The first thing is the terms of all offices states elected official will take office the first Monday in May this need to be changed to the first Monday in January. It also says that Council shall by ordinance fix the salaries and compensation of the municipal officers; this should be done by resolution. McCully would like to have a committee with the attorney to look at it and suggest changes. Banning stated we were waiting for codification to come back to see if these changes were made. Evans asked Banning to explain to Council what the codification consists of and what it means. Banning explained that it means compiling all the ordinances that have passed since the last codification in 1987. Evans asked Rebo if the codifiers would be open to the council's input. Fran McCully stated yes. Rebo added but, any changes that they do will still be done with an ordinance. Discussion followed. Fisher requested to have Ordinance #263 be placed on the next work meeting. A committee of Fisher and McCully will work with Evans and will present their changes at the work meeting.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Janine Price asked if there was an expected time frame to have the codification complete. It was discussed and estimated around October.
