

**Troy Council Special Meeting
Council Chambers
July 25, 2013
6:00 pm**

The meeting came to order at 6:00 pm. Present: Mayor Anthony Brown And Council: Phil Fisher, Fran McCully, Joe Arts, and Crystal Denton, City Attorney Heather McDougall, Administrative Assistant Brad Jones and Deputy City Clerk Sandi Sullivan.

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order.

TCI CONTRACT: Mayor Brown had questions on the plan. McCully clarified that it will loop. There was discussion regarding the size of the line starting upward in 6" and come back in 2". Engineer confirmed the plan. Discussion followed. Estimated costs came in at \$65,000. Brad Jones let council know that RPA advised that the project cannot go over \$25,000 without having to charge Davis Bacon Wages. Jones checked the MCA's and thinks it can go under maintenance. He advised that he will have the answer tomorrow, the 26th of July. If the answer is that it can go under maintenance, it will not have a cost increase.

IRON CREEK WELL: Mayor Brown let know that he had been in contact with Paul Rumelhart, and he is going to start on an Economic Development grant to start on the well on Iron Creek. Jones talked to a gentleman in Helena and it could be 2015 before seeing grant funding. Mayor Brown stated that Rumelhart may consider this an emergency grant, so the funding could be sooner.

Phil Fisher Made the Motion to accept the TCI Contract on the contingency that it doesn't increase; Joe Arts seconded. Motion Carried.
