

**Troy Council Work Meeting

The meeting came to order at 6:30 pm. Present: Mayor Anthony Brown And Council: Phil Fisher, Fran McCully, Joe Arts, and Crystal Denton, City Attorney Heather McDougall, Administrative Assistant Brad Jones and City Clerk Tracy Rebo.

GLENN HERMAN: James Benedict Memorial – [heard during public comments of August 8, 2013 Special Meeting]

ORDINANCE No. 655: Codification – Mayor Brown asked if there was any discussion on the codification Ordinance. Discussion regarding Evans' changes followed.

RESOLUTION No. 669: Sprinkling and Oiling FY 13/14- Mayor Brown opened up Resolution No. 669 for discussion. Rebo advised that any rate changes will need a public hearing. She advised that the current rate is twenty cents per foot. Rebo continued; if you feel the increase is needed, we can hold the public hearing and vote on it when the preliminary budget is voted on. Discussion followed.

BUDGET CONCERNS: Fran McCully- Mayor Brown opened the floor to McCully. McCully started with her concerns with the sidewalks, gas apportionment, sprinkling and oiling. She would like to see some money budgeted for the sidewalk to go from the elementary school to the highway.

McCully next concern was wages, the cost allocation for the water and sewer rounds. Discussion held on what to charge customers for services provided by the City. Discussion was held on policies for the water and sewer utilities.

McCully next concern is the wages, would like to look into reducing the police department and leaving at two officers. Discussion held on Administrative Assistant wages for FY14 and letting department heads run their department without having an administrative assistant.

A lot of discussion was held on department head evaluations, when they should be done and who is responsible to do them.
