

**Troy Council Work Meeting  
Council Chambers  
March 12, 2015  
6:30 pm**

Present: President of Council Crystal Denton, Council: Joe Arts, Dallas Carr and Kimberly Rowse; and City Clerk Tracy Rebo Mayor Darren Coldwell excused absent.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** None

**BUDGET AMENDMENT - Increase Funding for Water Department:** The increase in the budget is necessary because the pump in well#1 has went out and no longer works. The Bid came in at \$31,115.10 but may increase to as much as \$35,000.00. Rowse had a question as to where it would come from. Rebo explained.

**BUDGET AMENDMENT- Increase Supplies in Streets:** The increase requested is to budget monies to purchase banners, baskets, and trees to place along the walking path, and to paint the caboose. These were donated funds. Rebo explained that there will only be \$12,000 spent of the \$16,000 this budget year. There was discussion on how to keep the planters soaked and being done professionally.

**ENGINEERING CONTRACT:** Crystal Denton explained that the projected plan of doing two streets has been downsized to one street if funds are not available. Rebo explained that with the unexpected well pump replacement in need of \$35,000, the projected \$100,000 project would be too much drain on the water department's operating cash. Rowse asked if the contract would stand for next year when funding allows, or if it would need to be re-bid. Rebo advised that she will have Public Works Director Dave Norman to follow up with RPA. Rebo stated that there were more bids received but Robert Peccia and Associates (RPA) was the lowest.

**FINAL PLAT APPROVAL: Rosebud Subdivision:** There was no information yet, but expecting it in to City Hall by Friday morning. This approval is still scheduled to be on the agenda next week.

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT REVIEW BOARD COMMITTEE- Approve their budget:** Crystal Denton advised that there is no information received from the committee. McCully advised that Fisher had emailed the Mayor regarding the budget. McCully estimated amounts that would change the Committee's projected budget. Dallas Carr asked why the Governmental Review Board picked Pinesdale to research. McCully answered; because they have a town hall form of government. Discussion followed. Kimberly Rowse asked if the Committee knew what Troy wanted. McCully answered; that it is a need to educate them so they can inform the people. Discussion followed.
