Mayor Darren Coldwell brought Meeting to order at 7:00 pm. He led the pledge of allegiance.

**MINUTES:** The Minutes of March 12, 2015 Work Meeting and the Minutes of March, 18 2015 Regular Council Meeting were reviewed by Council and Kimberly Rowse made the **Motion** to approve; Crystal Denton seconded. **Motion Carried.**

**DEPARTMENT REPORTS:** Mayor Coldwell updated Council of the new pump for well#2, trees and the water system on St. Regis Haul Road, Arbor Day and cleanup day with the school, and the ice skating rink. Question was answered regarding the damage to the hydrant at the school that was hit by a truck. Damage was taken care of and the company will be charged for the damage.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**BUSINESS LICENSES:** *E & A Detailing:* Owners: Eric Cox and Ashley Denton Location: at 213 E Missoula Avenue in Troy. Cox gave a brief explanation of business and answered questions. A **Motion** to approve the 2015 Business License for *E & A Detailing* was made by Dallas Carr and Second Joe Arts. **Motion Carried.**

*Eric Harding – Telecommuting Office:* Owner: Eric Harding Location: 302 E Missoula Avenue in Troy Montana. It was decided by Council and Mayor that Mr. Harding would not be required to purchase a business license.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**RESOLUTION No. 2015-698: ANNEXATION-** Mayor Coldwell explained the reasoning for annexations of both properties, including the paperwork, and the fees were waived. Crystal Denton agreed on the reasoning for waving the fees. A **Motion** was made to approve Resolution No. 2015-698, the property located at 113 W Spokane Avenue by Crystal Denton and seconded by Kimberly Rowse. **Motion Carried.**

**RESOLUTION No. 2015-699: ANNEXATION-** a Motion was made to approve Resolution No. 2015-699, the properties located at 112 W Spokane Avenue and 114 W Spokane Avenue by Crystal Denton and seconded by Dallas Carr. **Motion Carried.**

**ROOSEVELT PARK HOST:** Mayor Coldwell advised of the pros and cons of having a park host. A discussion was held and it was determined that there is a need for one. The **Motion** was made to advertise for a park host by Kimberly Rowse. Dallas Carr seconded the Motion, **Motion Carried.**

**CLAIMS:** There were question answered regarding the hanging baskets and the Economic Development meeting in Helena. The Apartments were discussed. Dallas Carr thanked the City for the Flags at the Park and Ball Field. It was pointed out that the homesteader's claim for clothing was for the Electric Department as it is a new OSHA regulation that their clothing be Fire Retardant. Possibility of a city vehicle was discussed because of the cost of training per diem for mileage. Rowse requested a report from the Building Inspector regarding his training. Joe Arts made the **Motion** to approve the claims in the amount of \$197,672.10 Kimberly Rowse seconded. **Motion Carried.**
