ORDINANCE 2015-711: 4-Way stop located at Third Street and Riverside Avenue- Mayor Coldwell explained that citizens have approached him with concerns for the need of a 4-Way stop at the intersection of Third Street and Riverside Avenue.

LOAN FOR PATROL VEHICLES: LCCU - Rural Development Agreement for PD Vehicles – City Clerk, Tracy Rebo advised that there is has been no information received from the Credit Union at this time. There was discussion on another grant for equipment.

ANNEXATION: 113 W Spokane Avenue – Coldwell explained that there was an error when sent to the County for permanent record so this needed to be corrected by the City and resubmitted. He reiterated that it has already been approved but advised that it will again appear on the next agenda.

RESOLUTION No. 2015-713: Property purchase- It was brought to the City, the opportunity to purchase adjoining property at 322 E Yaak Avenue. Said property is one lot (25' X 125'), the parcel that connects to existing City property along the Yaak Avenue apartments, for a total cost of \$6,666.00 plus closing cost.
