

**Troy Council Meeting  
Council Chambers  
December 16, 2015  
7:00 pm**

Present: Mayor, Darren Coldwell, Council: Crystal Denton, Joe Arts, Dallas Carr, and Kimberly Rowse, and City Clerk Tracy Rebo.

Mayor Darren Coldwell brought the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. and led the pledge of allegiance.

**GUESTS:** John Clogston, Zoe Lowery, Dakota Hake, Mariah Britton, Delaine Garrison, Lana Garrison.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** John Clogston requested the Council to look at the water leakage again. He stated that big leaks are masking the little leaks. Mayor agreed.

**MINUTES: Motion** to approve the minutes of November 18, 2015 was made by Joe Arts. Crystal Denton seconded. **Motion Carried.** Kimberly Rowse made a Motion to approve the Minutes of November 13, 2015 and Dallas Carr seconded. **Motion Carried.**

**DEPARTMENT REPORTS:** Mayor Coldwell advised that the City received community improvement grant which will go to purchasing a flag pole, bike racks, and park benches at the Museum.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**CHAPEL FLATS ROAD: Adoption** – Mayor Coldwell informed the Council of the dedication of the remaining side of Chapel Flats Road from the Owner to the City. He advised that there is no planning of improving the road. Coldwell stated that this will come up again in the new year once the information can be gathered from the City Attorney regarding the process.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2015-711 PERSONNEL POLICY – Change in Section 1170** - Mayor Coldwell explained the reasoning for the clarification on wording. Discussion followed. Crystal Denton made a **Motion** to approve Resolution No. 2015-711 with the amendment to delete the five words *police personnel see police manual*. Motion seconded by Dallas Carr. **Motion Carried.**

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**CLAIMS:** Clogston asked if the claim concerning the police light bars was for only one vehicle or all three. Mayor answered that it was for three vehicles. Denton asked if it placing a propane tank at the park host location was followed through with. Coldwell answered, yes. There were more questions regarding equipment for the three police vehicles. Coldwell explained the Local Government fee is required for turning in the annual financial report. He also mentioned the USDA Forest Service are the annual fees for easements. Carr asked about the claim for chainsaw parts through Watts Saw Shop. It was discussed. Rowse asked about the Crane Truck. Mayor Coldwell explained. Crystal Denton made the **Motion** to approve Claims in the amount of \$105,574.99 and Joe Arts seconded. **Motion Carried.**

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Dakota Hake asked if the City can donate the school cheerleading for uniforms. Mayor Coldwell explained why the City cannot donate. He suggested asking the employees.
