

**Troy Council Budget Meeting

August 16, 2016

Mayor Darren Coldwell brought the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. and led the pledge of allegiance.

DISCUSSION:

Request for out building for shop area: it was asked what equipment and or supplies were out in the weather. Both Taylor and Norman explained. Taylor added that he needed to run this by the building inspector to see if an engineer needed. He was advised to see if the company had engineering plans. There was discussion on the snow load. All council members ok with proceeding as long as cost is kept to below \$24,000.

Sewer: January 1, 2017, there will be an infiltration study requiring an engineering firm. Costs should be around \$4,000.

BPA Energy Efficiency surplus funds: It was explained that these funds were received by the rebate programs and goes to the City for invoicing and administrative costs. There is around \$14,000. The Mayor would like to see it go to some updated Christmas lighting. Fran McCully questioned the Economic Development money and the Wildlife Interpreter's Center.

Wage: Discussion took place regarding wage difference between percentages.
