

**Troy Council Work Meeting

Present: Mayor, Darren Coldwell, Council: Crystal Denton, Joe Arts, Dallas Carr, and Kimberly Rowse, City Clerk Tracy Rebo.

Mayor Darren Coldwell brought the meeting to order at 6:30 pm

PUBLIC COMMENTS: None

WORK MEETING DATES: Discussion – Mayor Coldwell asked the Council to consider changing the monthly work meetings from the second Thursday of the month to the second Wednesday of the month. Discussion followed. He will call for a motion at the next Council meeting.

IBEW CONTRACT: FY 16/17, 17/18, 18/19 - Council reviewed the 3 year IBEW contract which includes a 2% wage increase per year. Questions and concerns were discussed.

FOWL (CHICKEN) ORDINANCE: Discussion regarding allowing fowl within the limits of Troy was discussed. Karuzas expressed his feelings to allow hens, and agrees that roosters should not be allowed. Mayor Coldwell would like the ordinance to state minimum yard size requirements and placements of enclosures. Kimberly Rowse also expressed her views. Mayor Coldwell asked the Council to review this and email him their ideas.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: John Clogston asked the Council if they had received a copy of the water being pumped versus what is being used. Dallas Carr expressed his disconcert with Clogston's request. He added that the County does many in-kind services for the City as well. It was the consensus of the Council to continue letting the County get water out of the unmetered hydrant.
