

**Troy Council Meeting
Council Chambers
October 19, 2016
7:00 pm**

Present: Mayor, Darren Coldwell, Council: Joe Arts, Dallas Carr, Kimberly Rowse, and City Clerk Tracy Rebo. Crystal Denton excused absent.

Mayor Darren Coldwell brought the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. and led the pledge of allegiance.

MINUTES: The minutes of the August 23, 2016 budget meeting, September 7, 2016 Preliminary Budget Public Hearing and Final Budget Adoption, and September 21, 2016 regular council meeting were presented to council for approval. There were no corrections or concerns. **Motion** to approve the Minutes of August 23, 2016 was made by Joe Arts and seconded by Kimberly Rowse, **Motion Carried**. A **Motion** to approve the Minutes of September 7, 2016 Public Hearing was made by Dallas Carr and seconded by Joe Arts, **Motion Carried**. **Motion** to approve the Minutes of September 7, 2016 Budget Adoption, was made by Joe Arts and seconded by Dallas Carr, **Motion Carried**.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS: Mayor Coldwell brought up the three estimates received for the equipment shed that will be behind the city shop. The estimates were reviewed and they came in below the budgeted amount. Coldwell advised that the City has received two grants for a kiosk at the fishing pond, flowers for the museum, and new sidewalk(s). Department heads submitted written reports for council review.

NEW BUSINESS:

CHANGE WORK MEETING DATES: Joe Arts made a **Motion** to approve the move from the second Thursday to the second Wednesday of every month for Council work meetings. Kimberly Rowse seconded. **Motion Carried**.

OLD BUSINESS:

RESOLUTION No. 2016-729: Setting Salaries and Wages - Mayor Coldwell asked if there were any questions. None were heard. **Motion** to approve Resolution No. 2016-729 setting the salaries and wages for FY 16/17 was made by Kimberly Rowse and seconded by Dallas Carr. **Motion Carried**.

IBEW CONTRACT: Employee union contract was brought up for discussion. Rowse stated that she would like to see a sentence rewritten regarding specialized clothing and footwear. It is unnecessary verbiage. Kimberly Rowse made the **Motion** to approve the IBEW Contract for the FY 16/17, FY 17/18, and FY 18/19 with the change of wording, and Dallas Carr seconded. **Motion Carried**.

CITY OF TROY CODE 5-2-5: Swine, livestock, and domestic animals discussion: Mayor Coldwell asked Council to Table discussion until the November 16 meeting to have more time to review the other community ordinances. **Motion to Table** was made by Kimberly Rowse and seconded by Joe Arts. **Motion Carried.**

Discussion was held on claims. **Motion** to approve cancelled check #21057 in the amount of \$12,137.98 to Lincoln County was made by Joe Arts and seconded by Kimberly Rows **Motion Carried.** **Motion** to approve the claims in the amount of \$161,680.94 was made and Dallas Carr seconded. **Motion Carried.**
