

**Troy Council Work Meeting
Council Chambers
November 09, 2016
6:30 p.m.**

Present: Council President Presiding: Crystal Denton, Council: Joe Arts, Dallas Carr, and Kimberly Rowse, City Clerk Tracy Rebo. Mayor Darren Coldwell excused

President Crystal Denton brought the meeting to order at 6:30 pm

GUESTS: Charles Curtis, Elaine Smith-Hammer

PUBLIC COMMENTS: None

CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT: Storage Building -.There was discussion on ordering a pre-fabricated structure versus the City crew building the storage building.

CITY COURT REQUEST: Bonds set- it was explained that having preset bonds would allow the police department to collect fees instantly. It was explained that the police department doesn't want to be responsible for funds. Council consensus was to keep things as they are until they have more information on what other towns do, and more reasons for a change.

CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING: Tracy Rebo updated council on plans for tree lighting November 26, 2016. Carr advised that there was a donation of 200 ft. light strings. More Ideas were discussed.

INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BOARD OF HEALTH: Following up from an August meeting where Nick Raines described the need for Troy area board members and asked Council for input, Kimberly Rowse gave a few names for suggestions.

UNION CONTRACT: Council's consensus was: no problem with added memorandum.

FOWL (CHICKEN) ORDINANCE: Crystal Denton asked for more time to get feedback from other Cities and Towns and bring them back to next work meeting. Elaine Smith-Hammer asked if there was a bee ordinance. No there isn't, discussion followed regarding hives.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Charles Curtis spoke. He purchased the Pine Tree Plaza. He explained that he has a motor home there while cleaning up the

burned building. He's aware of the ordinance not allowing residential RVs. He requested a variance to the Ordinance and brought with him two letters of support from community members, and the deed to the property. Kimberly Rowse expressed that she would like to see the City work with him to move forward on the cleanup. Discussion on plans for the building followed.
