

**Troy Council Work Meeting  
Council Chambers  
March 8, 2017  
6:30 pm**

Present: Mayor Darren Coldwell: Joe Arts, Crystal Denton, Dallas Carr, and City Clerk Tracy Rebo. Kimberly Rowse unexcused absent.

Mayor Coldwell brought the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

**GUESTS:** Elka Wood – The Western News, Allen Dye – Chief of Police, John Clogston, and John Konzen

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** None.

**CONTRACT** - Peddlers Park Grant: Mayor advised that the City received the working agreement. More discussion was held. Tracy Rebo will follow up by sending it to the City Attorney for clarification.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** – Pump Track: Mayor Coldwell advised that Shayna Bernall will be at the March 15, 2017 regular Council Meeting to answer questions.

**PERSONNEL POLICY:** Mayor let Council know that City Clerk Rebo had updated the personnel policy with the MMIA suggestions and it will be sent to the City Attorney for review to see if it complies with the union contract.

**ORDINANCE No. 2017-730-** Fees for Chickens: Coldwell gave examples of the fees from other towns. It was Council's consensus to go with the \$25.00 permit fee for chickens.

**COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS** – Dallas Carr: wanted to do a newsletter to clean up the community. Mayor Coldwell is concerned that sending out over 900 letters to get 12 people to clean up their yards is expensive. Police Chief Allen Dye stated there needs to be some penalty behind the legislation. Carr feels it is unfair for us to take the majority of the complaining and would like to have the Police Department to see what needs to be done. Coldwell would like to establish an Ordinance to have passed concerning un-kept yards with a stiff penalty. Allen Dye will work with Carr and follow up.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Joe Arts brought up the article in the newspaper concerning Troy's animal control. He stated that he sees it as a service Troy should provide. Allen Dye said he may have a few ideas for Animal Control.
