

**Troy Council Work Meeting**

Present: Mayor Darren Coldwell: Joe Arts, Crystal Denton, Dallas Carr, and City Clerk Tracy Rebo. Kimberly Rowse excused absent.

Mayor Coldwell brought the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
