

**Troy Council Work Meeting

POLICE CHIEF ASSISTANT: Mayor Coldwell advised that he had spoken with the Chief regarding the assistant. Chief Davis would like to reinstate and keep Allen Dye as a training officer. She would like her budget to show 20 hours a pay period for the assistant.

CITY ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS: Bonds - Chief Davis requested that violators of the Junk Vehicle and Refuse Ordinances be notified somehow either by letter or on the monthly utility billing card this would justify following through with a fine. Carr spoke with the Judge and relayed the message that she would really like a bond schedule.

SEWER RATES: City Clerk Rebo advised Mayor and Council of the condition of the sewer utility finances. She reported that the City is not in compliance with the Sewer Bond. The Mayor would like to see a flat rate increase, not based on water usage. Rebo will follow up with communications with the auditor for suggestions.
